

Living Flower Arrangement Workshop Planning Sheet

We would like to introduce you to the wonderful world of container gardening with flower bulbs.

The first segment of the workshop will start with a slide presentation (where possible) of potentials and possibilities of the many ways to use bulbs in and on containers. We will talk about the varied techniques and requirements for forcing spring flowering bulbs as well as the best conditions to grow summer flowering bulbs in containers. You will discover how easy and how much fun it is to enjoy a container garden in a variety of exciting ways.

We will review a display of some of the best selections of all types of bulbs that may be enjoyed in containers.

After the slide presentation and/or lecture, each person will receive a 12" tall X 12" wide vinyl pot in which they will follow Brent's demonstration and successively layer 4 or 5 types of bulbs in concentric layers to achieve a color themed arrangement of bulbs to bloom simultaneously or sequentially.

Requirements of the host for the workshop

1. Decide on the color theme - only one for your group
 - A. Patriotic - red, white & blue
 - B. Cool and Calm - pink, white & purple
 - C. Warm and Wonderful - red, yellow & orange
 - D. Light up the Night - mostly white
2. Order the bulbs for the collections from Brent and Becky's Bulbs at least 1 month prior to workshop.
3. If your seminar is scheduled to be held at Brent and Becky's, we will include pots and compost.
4. If your seminar is at your location, we will ship the pots with the bulbs if you let us know that is what you want.
OR you may get some from your local garden center; order 12" wide X at least 9" deep vinyl pots for each participant
5. If your seminar is at your location, you need to have enough coarse perennial or shrub growing mix that has bark in it to fill each pot (i.e. Fafard #3 or equivalent; approximately one cubic ft. bag for 3 pots)
6. Print a list of bulbs in the collection for each participant (*availability of suggested bulbs is subject to change*)
7. Make copies of the 'Living Flower Arrangements Care Instructions' available on our web site for each participant
8. Provide enough table space for each participant to work comfortably (3-6 per table)
9. Perhaps offer disposable rubber gloves for participants.
